Premiering exclusively on Netflix worldwide this fall, this production utilizes Unreal Engine 5 and is co-produced by SAFEHOUSE, raising high expectations for an unprecedented Gundam visual experience. STORY

In U.C. 0079, the Principality of Zeon declared its independence from the Earth Federation government, igniting a war that engulfed the world. Zeon's forces initially held an advantage due to their innovative mobile suit weaponry. However, their strength proved insufficient to completely conquer Earth, resulting in a stalemate.

Eleven months into the conflict, the Federation Forces seized one of Zeon's bases in Eastern Europe. Zeon responded by dispatching a composite battalion, including a newly arrived mobile suit squadron from space – Solari and her Red Wolves team.

HG Gundam EX (Requiem for Vengeance)

The Gundam EX, the formidable opponent of the Red Wolves Squad in *Mobile Suit Gundam: Requiem for Vengeance*, is now available as an HG kit. Its unique design is accurately captured with all-new parts, and it comes equipped with its signature weapons. Enjoy dynamic poses thanks to its wide range of articulation.



It has far more dense and intricate molds compared to standard HG kits. It meticulously recreates the fully CG-rendered MS design down to the finest detail. The kit comes with a beam rifle and shield.

▲ With a movabled beam saber rack, it can strike dynamic poses simulating saber drawing.

The Zaku II F-Type piloted by Solari, Captain of the Red Wolves Squad, is now available as a new HG kit. Its distinctive top-heavy silhouette, complete with massive shoulder shield and spike armor, is accurately reproduced with all-new parts.



▲ The body is highly detailed like the Gundam EX. The head has two antennas, indicative of a commander's unit, with accurate left-right color differentiation. It is equipped with a Zaku machine gun and a heat hawk.

▲ The heat hawk can be mounted on the back of the waist.



▲ The shoulder shield has four spikes and three machine guns. Even the smallest details, such as the rear cylinders of the shield and the magazines of the machine guns, are molded with a high level of detail.



▲ The Power Pipe runs from the thigh to the tibia. It has a flexible central axis that allows it to follow the movement of the leg.

STORY

The head is from a prototype from another project, the exterior of the armor is based on data from a mysterious machine that was abandoned in the design stage, and a newly customized shield has been prepared for it. It is painted in the silver color that symbolizes the Argent Keil.

▲ Originally intended as spare parts for Neo Zeon remnants, Argent Keil acquired and modified a Jagd Goga into the JW-001 Jagd Weise. All psycommu equipment has been removed. Enhanced sensors and redesigned shoulder shields contribute to increased thruster capacity. Armed with a special

Originally released in July 1980, the iconic 1/144 Gundam has been reborn with all-new parts. This model incorporates the latest Gunpla technologies: Touch Gates (no tools required for assembly), Snap-fit (no glue required), and color-molded plastic (no painting required).







MOBILE SUIT GUNDAM F90 Atozpholecti

The 1991 theatrical release *Mobile Suit Gundam F91*, set in Universal Century 0123, marked a significant departure from its predecessor, *Mobile Suit Gundam: Char's Counterattack*. Featuring drastically advanced MS operating methods, the movie ushered in a new era for the *Gundam* franchise and expanded the possibilities within the Universal Century setting. Prior to this cinematic release, *Mobile Suit Gundam F90* was introduced as a pre-project and later expanded into a multimedia franchise that included Gunpla, comics, and games, enriching the world of *Gundam F91*. Since 2019, the "F90 A to Z PROJECT" has revived the series, focusing on Master Grade kits. It has introduced Gunpla models based on never-before-seen mission packs, as well as designs that once existed only as blueprints. To date, 23 of the 26 planned mission pack variations have been released. Gundam Forward magazine, in its 14th and 15th issues, features an in-depth look at the "Mobile Suit Gundam F90 A to Z PROJECT," exploring four core Gundam F90 types and eleven mission pack variations through design drawings and custom Gunpla builds.
